A. Out of this appropriation, \$331,593 the first year and \$331,593 the second year from the general fund is allocated to continue a statewide respite care initiative for the elderly and persons suffering from Alzheimer's Disease.

B. Out of this appropriation, \$20,000 the first year and \$20,000 the second year is provided from the general fund to support a program of medical transportation for the elderly in Floyd County.

C. Out of this appropriation, \$90,000 the first year and \$90,000 the second year is provided from the general fund to support adult day care services in Oxbow.

D. Out of this appropriation, \$175,199 the first year and \$175,199 the second year is provided from the general fund to support projects for family support, family respite, adult day care, and guardianship of vulnerable elderly Virginians.
