Authority: Title 46.2, Chapters 1, 2, 3, 6, 8, 10, 12, 15, 16, and 17; §§ [18.2-266](#) through [18.2-272](#); Title 58.1, Chapters 21 and 24, Code of Virginia. Title 33, Chapter 4, United States Code.

The Commissioner, Department of Motor Vehicles, is authorized to establish, where feasible and cost efficient, contracts with private-public partnerships with commercial operations, to provide for simplification and streamlining of service to citizens through electronic means. Provided, however, that such commercial operations shall not be entitled to compensation as established under § [46.2-205](#), Code of Virginia, but rather at rates limited to those established by the Commissioner.
