Authority: Title 2.1, Chapter 11, Code of Virginia.

A. Out of the amounts for State Agency/Local Legal Assistance and Advice shall be paid:

1. The salary of the Attorney General, \$97,500 per year from July 1, 1996 to January 16, 1998, and \$110,667 per year from January 17, 1998 to June 30, 1998.
2. Expenses of the Attorney General not otherwise reimbursed, \$9,000 each year in equal monthly installments.
3. Salary expenses necessary to provide legal services pursuant to Title 2.1, Chapter 11, Code of Virginia.

B. Upon notification by the Attorney General, agencies that administer programs which are funded wholly or partially from nongeneral fund appropriations shall transfer to the Department of Law the necessary funds to cover the costs of legal services. The Attorney General shall determine the amounts for transfer.

C. The Department of Law shall monitor the additional time and resources allocated to the defense of state agencies for claims against statewide insurance policies.
