Authority: Title 2.1, Chapter 32, Articles 3 and 6, Code of Virginia.

A. The amounts for Surplus and Excess Property Management-Federal and for Surplus Transfer or Sale - State shall be paid solely from revenues derived from charges for services. The estimated subprogram cost for Surplus and Excess Property Management-Federal is \$892,456 the first year and \$\$892,456 the second year. The estimated cost for Surplus Transfer or Sale-State is \$713,826 the first year and \$713,826 the second year.

- B.1. No later than September 1, 1998, the Department of General Services shall use a single, consolidated statewide list to inform state agencies and political subdivisions of all generic and brand name computer systems, components, and peripheral equipment available on state contract.
- 2. No later than January 1, 1999, the Departments of General Services and Information Technology shall develop uniform policies and procedures for procuring telecommunications products and services for state agencies and institutions.
- 3. The Director of the Department of General Services shall evaluate the statewide delegated procurement authority purchasing threshold, and consider raising it to \$30,000 consistent with §11-41, Code of Virginia. A report on such evaluation and actions generated by the evaluation shall be submitted to the Chairmen of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance Committees by October 1, 1998.
