Authority: Title 44, Chapters 3.2, 3.3, 3.4, Code of Virginia.

A. Out of the amount for Disaster Operations shall be paid to the Civil Air Patrol from the general fund \$64,572 the first year and \$64,572 the second year. The provisions of § 2.1-394.1, Code of Virginia, and § 4-5.07 of this act shall not apply to the Civil Air Patrol.

B. All funds transferred to the Department of Emergency Services pursuant to the Governor's authority under § [44-146.28](#), Code of Virginia, shall be deposited into a special fund account to be used only for Disaster Recovery.
