Authority: §§ 4-1 through 4-118.2, Code of Virginia.

*A. No later than October 1, 1999, the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control shall submit to the Governor and Chairmen of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance Committees a detailed business plan for inventory management and the impact of the Product Distribution System (PDS) on inventories.*

*B. No later than October 1, 1999, the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control shall submit to the Governor and Chairmen of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance Committees a detailed business plan for opening new stores during FY 2000, including location and criteria, sales and profit goals.*

*C. No later than September 1, 1999, the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control shall submit to the Governor and Chairmen of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance Committees a work plan and cost estimates for renovations, redecoration initiatives, and other necessary improvements to statewide ABC retail outlets.*
