Authority: Title 45.1, Chapter 26, Code of Virginia.

A. Out of the amounts for Energy Conservation Advisory Services shall be provided \$38,362 the first year and \$38,362 the second year from the general fund for dues and expenses for the Southern States Energy Board.

B. Out of the amounts for Other Services shall be provided \$1,800,000 the first year and \$4,500,000 the second year from the general fund for solar photovoltaic manufacturing incentive grants in accordance with § [45.1-392](#), Code of Virginia.
