Authority: Title 28.2, Chapters 12, 13, 14, and 15; Title 62.1, Chapters 16 and 19, Code of Virginia.

A. Pursuant to § [28.2-1210](#), Code of Virginia, \$100,000 the first year and \$100,000 the second year from the general fund shall be allocated for projects to remove abandoned vessels, deteriorated structures and waterway obstructions posing a hazard to recreational boating and the natural environment in the Elizabeth River. Any unexpended general fund balances remaining on June 30, 2000, June 30, 2001, and June 30, 2002, shall be reappropriated.

B. Included in this amount is \$15,000 the first year from the general fund for removal of the remnant pilings at Wares Wharf that are a hazard to navigation, pursuant to § [28.2-1210](#), Code of Virginia.
