Included within this appropriation is \$6,000,000 the second year from the Wireless E-911 Fund to establish a grant program to assist localities that are making a good-faith effort to develop E-911 wireline emergency telephone services but have a demonstrated financial need for state assistance. The Department of Technology Planning shall provide a status report on the implementation of the grant program, including proposed guidelines to be used in the grant application process, by December 1, 2001, to the Governor, Chairmen of the Senate Finance and House Appropriations Committees, and the Chairman of the State Crime Commission.
