Authority: Title 10.1, Chapter 21, Code of Virginia.

A. The amounts provided to localities and planning district commissions for financial assistance in implementing the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Act shall be distributed on a competitive basis. Consideration shall be given to the availability of local resources, with more funding provided to localities with the greatest needs and where the greatest water quality benefits can be generated.

B. The June 30, 2000, June 30, 2001, and June 30, 2002 unexpended balances for grants to localities and planning district commissions are hereby reappropriated.

C. Of the amounts in the Land Management program, the Department may expend a portion of its general fund appropriation for a water quality monitoring project in Caroline County.

*D. The general fund revenues available for appropriation listed for the second year in Enactment No.2 of this act include reversions in the amount of \$43,257 from the reappropriations authorized in this Item.*
