A.1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 27, Article 2.2, Code of Virginia, \$176,697,829 the first year and ~~\$188,713,282~~ \$173,038,321 the second year from the general fund is hereby appropriated for purposes of Financial Assistance to Localities-General (Other Services), to be apportioned to localities with qualifying police departments in accordance with the provisions of ~~Title 9, Chapter 27, Article 2.2~~ Title 9.1, Chapter 1, Article 8, Code of Virginia (House Bill 599).

2. *The appropriation reduction in this paragraph pursuant to Executive Order 74(01) is reflected in Item 543.05 of this act.*

B. For purposes of receiving funds in accordance with this program, it is the intention of the General Assembly that the Town of Boone's Mill shall be considered to have had a police department in operation since the 1980-82 biennium and is therefore eligible for financial assistance under ~~Title 9, Chapter 27, Article 2.2~~ Title 9.1, Chapter 1, Article 8, Code of Virginia (House Bill 599).
