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Authority: Title 44, Chapters 3.2, 3.3, 3.4, Code of Virginia.

A. Out of the amount for Disaster Operations shall be paid to the Civil Air Patrol from the general fund \$100,000 the first year and \$100,000 the second year. The provisions of ~~§ 2-1-394.1~~ [§ 2-2-1505](#), Code of Virginia, and ~~§ 4-5.07~~ of this act shall not apply to the Civil Air Patrol.

B. All funds transferred to the Department of Emergency ~~Services~~ *Management* pursuant to the Governor's authority under [§ 44-146.28](#), Code of Virginia, shall be deposited into a special fund account to be used only for Disaster Recovery.

C. Out of the amount for Disaster Operations shall be paid to the City of Franklin \$4,000,000 the first year from the general fund for disaster relief, for reconstruction of the Franklin City Hall and renovation of the Franklin Public Safety Building.
