Authority: Title 45.1, Chapter 26, Code of Virginia.

A. Out of the amounts for Energy Conservation Advisory Services shall be provided \$38,362 the first year and \$38,362 the second year from the general fund for dues and expenses for the Southern States Energy Board.

B. Out of the amounts for Other Services shall be provided ~~\$2,700,000~~ \$1,647,636 the second year from the general fund for solar photovoltaic manufacturing incentive grants in accordance with § 45.1-392, Code of Virginia. Notwithstanding § 45.1-392, Code of Virginia, or any other provision of law, the solar photovoltaic manufacturing incentive grant program is deferred until fiscal year 2004. *It is the intent of the General Assembly to fulfill the commitment made for solar photovoltaic manufacturing incentive grants as stipulated in § 45.1-392, Code of Virginia.*
