Authority: Title 10.1, Chapters 11.1 and 13; Title 62.1, Chapters 3.1, 3.2 and 24, Code of Virginia.

A. This Item includes ~~\$225,000~~ \$127,563 the first year and ~~\$225,000 the second year~~ from the general fund to monitor water quality in the Elizabeth River. These funds shall be used to establish toxins analysis capabilities with the purpose of analyzing ambient water conditions in the Elizabeth River, collecting biological samples, and monitoring the performance of proposed best management practices.

B. ~~Out of this appropriation, \$30,126 the first year from the general fund shall be used to match U.S. Army Corps of Engineers funding for cleanup projects and wetlands restoration on the Elizabeth River.~~
