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Authority: Title 18.2, Chapter 8, Article 1.1:1, Code of Virginia.

A. Out of this appropriation, the members of the Charitable Gaming ~~Commission~~ *Board* shall receive compensation and reimbursement for their reasonable expenses in performance of their duties, as provided in § 2.2-2104, Code of Virginia.

B. Notwithstanding § 18.2-340.31C, Code of Virginia, any and all fees paid after June 30, 2003, by any organization conducting charitable gaming under a permit issued by the ~~Commission~~ *Department*, including audit and administrative fees and permit fees, shall be deposited to the general fund.

C. Omitted.

D. The ~~Commission~~ *Department* shall deposit into the Investigation Fund any assets it receives as a result of a law enforcement seizure and subsequent forfeiture by either a state or a federal court. The Fund shall be used to defray the expenses of the ~~Commission's~~ *Department's* investigation and enforcement actions and to purchase equipment for enforcement purposes.
