Authority: Title 10.1, Chapters 11.1, 13 and 14; Title 62.1, Chapters 3.1, 3.6, 20, 24 and 25, Code of Virginia.

A. The appropriation includes annual membership dues for the Interstate Commission on the Potomac River Basin, \$123,823 the first year and \$123,823 the second year, from the general fund.

B. The appropriation includes annual membership dues for the Ohio River Valley Water Sanitation Commission, \$43,700 the first year and \$43,700 the second year, from the general fund.

C. Out of the amounts for this Item shall be paid \$100,000 the first year and \$100,000 the second year from the general fund to the Chesapeake Bay Foundation to support Bay education field studies.
