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The Department of Accounts shall advance \$13,151,217 to the Department of General Services in anticipation of revenues to be received for the completion of the renovation and extension of the Capitol. These funds shall be used to finance the nongeneral fund authority for the cost of renovation, landscaping, furnishings, fixtures and equipment authorized in Chapter 897 of the 2004 Acts of Assembly. This revenue anticipation note may be repaid in whole or in part, without interest, at any time from grants, private donations, a general fund appropriation,

Virginia Public Building Authority bonds, or such other sources as may be available from the income of the Capitol Square Preservation Foundation.
