Authority: Title 9.1, Chapter 1, Articles 1 and 2, and §§ [9.1-117](#) and 9.1-122.

Out of this appropriation, \$1,600,000 the first year and \$1,600,000 the second year from the general fund shall be used to fund operating costs of the Norfolk Public Health Building. Of this amount, \$200,000 in the first year and \$200,000 in the second year has been transferred from the Department of Health as its portion of the ongoing operating costs of this facility
