Authority: Title 63.1, Chapter 5.1, Code of Virginia.

A. The Virginia Department for the Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing is authorized to locate the Relay Center in Norton, Virginia. In developing the request for proposals for the Relay Center, the Department shall include provisions to require that basic relay services be provided from the Center located in Norton, Virginia and that the Center maintain at least 105 full-time equivalent positions.

B. Out of this appropriation, \$40,000 the first year and \$40,000 the second year from the general fund shall be provided to the Connie Reasor Deaf Resource Center in Planning District 1.
