§ 3-6.02 E-911 TAX LINE OF DUTY FEE SURCHARGE

Notwithstanding the provisions of §§ [9.1-400-405](#), [§ 56-484.12](#) and [§ 58.1-1730](#), Code of Virginia, there is hereby assessed an \$0.18 surcharge imposed on the end user of each access line for which the \$0.75 E-911 fee is currently charged, as defined by [§ 56-484.12](#) and [§ 58.1-1730](#), Code of Virginia. Benefits paid under the Line of Duty Act shall be funded by the \$0.18 surcharge, which shall be billed, collected and remitted in the same manner as the E-911 fee and shall be deposited by the Virginia Information Technologies Agency and the Department of Taxation, as applicable, directly to the Line of Duty Death and Health Benefits Trust Fund of the state treasury and on the books of the State Comptroller.
