Authority: §§ 4-1 through 4-118.2, Code of Virginia and Item 643, Chapter 966 of the 1994 Acts of Assembly.

- A. Any plan to modernize and integrate the automated systems of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control shall be based on developing the integrated system in phases or modules.
- B. The Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control shall transfer \$35,000 the first year and \$35,000 the second year from nongeneral funds to the Governor's Office on Substance Abuse Prevention to support that agency's efforts to prevent tobacco and alcohol abuse by youth.
- C. Funds appropriated for services related to state lottery operations shall be used solely for lottery ticket purchases and prize payouts.
- D. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall open additional stores in locations deemed to have the greatest potential for total increased sales in order to maximize profitability.
