A. Out of this appropriation, \$1,883,112 from the general fund and \$14,350,000 from nongeneral funds the first year and \$1,601,121 from the general fund and \$14,350,000 from nongeneral funds the second year is designated to build research capacity in the areas of bioengineering and biosciences.

- B. Out of this appropriation, \$3,938,000 the first year and \$881,720 the second year from the general fund is designated for the support of cancer research.
- C. The Higher Education Operating fund source listed in this Item is considered to be a sum sufficient appropriation, which is an estimate of funding required by the university to cover sponsored program operations.
