A. Out of this appropriation, \$1,601,121 the first year and \$1,601,121 the second year from the general fund and \$14,350,000 the first year and \$14,350,000 the second year from nongeneral funds are designated to build research capacity in the areas of bioengineering and biosciences.

- B. Out of this appropriation, \$881,720 the first year and \$881,720 the second year from the general fund is designated for the support of cancer research.
- C. Out of this appropriation, \$1,500,000 the first year and \$1,500,000 the second year from the general fund is designated for support of the Focused Ultrasound Surgery Foundation to support core programs and research activities.
- D. The Higher Education Operating fund source listed in this Item is considered to be a sum sufficient appropriation, which is an estimate of funding required by the university to cover sponsored program operations.
