Authority: Title 23, Chapter 9.1, Code of Virginia.

A. Out of this appropriation, \$3,150,000 the first year and \$3,150,000 the second year from the general fund is provided to support undergraduate financial assistance and work study programs for low and middle income Virginia students consistent with the objectives of the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2011.

B. Out of this appropriation, \$376,910 the first year and \$376,910 the second year from the general fund is provided to support graduate financial aid.
