Out of this appropriation, \$1,050,377 the second year from the general fund and \$7,784,608 the second year from nongeneral funds is provided for salary increases for direct care staff. In addition to the funds included in this Item, \$8,414,272 the first year is provided for these purposes in Item 486 out of the revenues received from the federal distributions of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.
