2000 REPORT OF THE EDUCATION SUBCOMMITTEE John H. Chichester, CHAIRMAN

Members of the Committee:

The members of the subcommittee are pleased with the package of recommendations we bring to you this afternoon. I will turn first to public education:

Public Education

This Subcommittee remains committed to the improvement of our system of Public Education. We were delighted to begin our deliberations over the Public Education budget this year with an increase in funding of over \$600 million. This latest infusion represents more than an 8 percent increase in funding to support just under a 2 percent increase in students. Obviously, this will ease the funding burdens and increase the budget flexibility of our localities and local school divisions significantly over the next two years.

Our recommendations to amend the introduced budget deal primarily with two issues: first, we are recommending a \$108.6 million educational technology program that <u>all</u> of our school divisions will participate in. The first priority for these funds will be the completion of the infrastructure, hardware and software necessary to allow on-line SOL instruction, remediation, and testing in our high schools by the year 2003. Once each division's high schools reach this plateau, their local school board will be able to determine where the remainder of their technology funds should be spent.

The second issue is intertwined with the first. The introduced budget required the use of 100 percent of the available Literary Fund revenues in the first year and virtually all of the revenues in the second year to support the technology program. Had we done this, the Literary Fund traditional loan program would have ground to a halt. By providing additional security for the Literary Fund Equipment Notes, we are able to recommend a 5-year financing program for technology this biennium, similar to past programs. This allows the Literary Fund to continue making loans for school construction throughout the 2000-02 biennium. We believe the continuation of this traditional school construction funding program is of utmost importance.

We have recommended full funding of the Northern Virginia Cost of Competing Differential in the first year – a top priority for our Northern Virginia members. As we did two years ago, we are also recommending a one-year payment to school divisions to transition them to their recalculated composite index of local ability-to-pay. This is a one-time payment to ease the transition for sixty-two divisions. There are a number of other amendments contained in the Subcommittee's recommendations, and they are detailed in the attached spreadsheet.

I am also pleased to note one savings item in our Subcommittee Report – the reduction in funding required for VRS payments in this biennium. While the state will save approximately \$60 million in the public education budget due to this action, I am most pleased by the savings this represents for localities. Local school divisions will save <u>at least</u> the same amount, and likely much more. We urge local governing bodies to use the budget flexibility created by the significant infusion of new state funds and the savings from the reduction in VRS rates to provide at least a 2.4 percent salary increase for their local school teachers and other school employees.

Higher Education

Now, let's turn to higher education. The focus of the subcommittee was to round out the package provided in the bill as introduced, with a continued emphasis on basic funding issues.

First, we remain committed to sustaining faculty salaries at the 60th percentile, based on our best projection of the faculty salary market across the nation. To that end, we recommend an additional \$17 million in general funds for an average increase of 3.5 percent.

Our other priorities in higher education focused on such areas as providing sufficient faculty and staff to meet student demand, continuing to encourage technology and new means of delivering instruction, and addressing critical equipment needs. Our recommendations provide funding of about \$47 million, including:

- \$10.8 million to support instructional and workforce training programs, along with the costs of new campuses in the community college system;
- \$9.5 million for technology and computing system improvements;
- \$6.8 million to help James Madison University, Virginia Tech, and Christopher Newport University provide adequate staff for current enrollment levels; and
- \$2.8 million to support the collaborative Virtual Library program.

We also recommend a contribution of another \$10 million to the Commonwealth Health Research Board for its work in support of human health research.

In the area of capital outlay, the budget as introduced addresses a number of critical life safety and infrastructure projects. Again, our objective was to round out the package. We propose \$103 million of capital funding targeted primarily at those projects that have already been planned. Most importantly, we propose another \$10 million for maintenance reserve for higher education agencies. We continue to view this area as a critical issue that merits our attention.

For our cultural agencies, we are pleased to recommend \$7.0 million to complete our commitment of fully funding the formula for state aid to local libraries. And, we recommend an additional \$400,000 – on top of the additional \$400,000 in the budget as introduced – for grants to local arts agencies.

Finally, we extend our appreciation to the Governor's Blue Ribbon Commission on Higher Education for its work and innovative proposals. We agree wholeheartedly that stable, predictable funding is critical for higher education. This must be our first order of business over the next year, as the Joint Subcommittee on Higher Education Funding Policies completes it work. As we are completing this task, we recommend directing our colleges and universities to develop ways to better measure their accomplishments and to continue to explore opportunities to decentralize higher education.

The Subcommittee is pleased with the actions we are recommending in Public and Higher Education. We offer them for the consideration of the Committee.
