REPORT OF THE SUBCOMMITTEE

on

SPECIAL PROJECTS

Mr. Chairmen and Members of the Committee:

The Special Projects Subcommittee reviewed project requests totaling \$172.3 million for historic landmarks and nonstate agencies. This included about \$96 million for capital projects for consideration in a cultural bond bill.

We recognize the value of these organizations to the Commonwealth. The investment of some state funds in these cultural attractions and educational organizations is a sound move to bolster economic development and education in Virginia. In the last few years, with the economic downturn, we were not able to fund any of these organizations, although I would add that this body did try. Today, we find ourselves in a different situation. Given that we have available general funds, I believe it would be imprudent to issue debt.

Therefore, we offer for your consideration increased funding of \$45.2 million for historic landmarks and nonstate agencies above the proposed budget. The largest of these recommendations is for \$40 million for 24 capital projects that were considered in the cultural bond bill. While this is less than half of what these organizations requested, it is cash and reflects our commitment to one-time spending in this budget. The remaining \$5.2 million is allocated as grants to 106 organizations.

I ask the Committee to adopt these recommendations.
