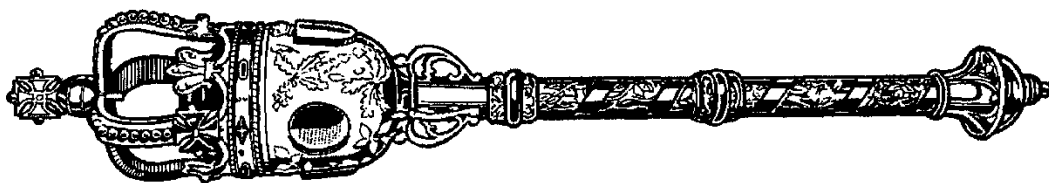

REPORT OF THE SUBCOMMITTEE

on

HIGHER EDUCATION

Mr. Chairman and Members of the Committee:

Mr. Chairman, increasing access and holding down costs for Virginia families has been the chief concern of this Committee for many years. Therefore, the Subcommittee's recommendations today continue to reflect the roadmap we passed in 2011 with the "Top Jobs for the 21st Century" legislation and our shared commitment of affordable access to our public colleges and universities. The Subcommittee recommendations reflect targeted investments that provides some additional operating support, faculty salary increases, and financial aid. The Subcommittee believes this will not only allow for greater access and affordability, but enhance the quality of our higher education system.

With that in mind, Mr. Chairman, the Subcommittee recommends amendments that provide for \$19.8 million additional operating support. Cumulatively, these funds will provide all institutions with about 44 percent of budget relief from the proposed reductions in the introduced budget. In addition, this recommendation provides enrollment growth for new in-state undergraduate seats for institutions with graduation rates above 60 percent. This builds on the 1,700 seat expansion from four years ago and expands the schools involved. Finally, these funds also provide enrollment growth for transfer students at the remaining senior institutions as well as the two-year colleges. This is intended as an incentive for those institutions to continue to grow their transfer programs with the community colleges as opposed to increasing first-time freshmen.

Using this “2 + 2” model will benefit the students with a less costly degree as well as provide a pathway to success.

The Subcommittee also recommends \$2.1 million in new financial aid funding. Of this amount, \$1.2 million is targeted for an innovative expansion of the transfer grant program. The Subcommittee is providing \$600,000 to six institutions to provide a \$1,000 “kicker” to the two-year transfer grant. Matching funds are also provided to SCHEV for the base transfer grant.

In addition to these funds, Mr. Chairman, the Subcommittee looked for ways to encourage and reward innovation and research at Virginia colleges and universities. To that end, the Subcommittee recommends \$5.0 million in the second year to support research efforts at our institutions. This includes funding for cancer research at UVA and VCU, brain disorder research at Virginia Tech, and biomedical research at ODU. In addition, the Subcommittee recommends the following innovative endeavors:


- Creation of the Commonwealth Center for Advanced Logistics Systems (CCALS) to be housed at VCU in partnership with industry. CCALS will begin by modeling ongoing operations at the Virginia Port Authority;
- Development and delivery of new education models for STEM-H and other high-demand credentials and careers at Richard Bland College;
- Two new degree pathways for veterans at George Mason, one in cybersecurity and the other in nursing; and,
- Development of a comprehensive online course offering by George Mason University.

Finally, Mr. Chairman, the Subcommittee is also pleased to recommend \$12 million for a two percent faculty salary increase at our higher education institutions. We are also pleased to recognize the funding contained in Central Accounts for compensation adjustments for our classified staff. I want to thank Mr. Poindexter for his work on this issue. Mr. Chairman, thank you for your leadership in making this possible for our hard working state employees.

When coupled with the reform legislation related to athletic fees, financial aid and greater autonomy, these recommendations will continue to build on our recent successes and offer Virginia students more opportunities to get a high quality, affordable education.

Mr. Chairman, details of our Subcommittee recommendations are attached. Committee staff will review our report and the attached listing of our recommendations in greater detail and I hope that it will be the pleasure of the Committee to adopt them.
