REPORT OF THE SUBCOMMITTEE
on
GENERAL GOVERNMENT & CAPITAL OUTLAY

Mr. Chairman and Members of the Committee:

I am pleased to present to you today the recommendations of the General Government & Capital Outlay Subcommittee. Consistent with the guidance we received from our Chairman, the Subcommittee approached its work this session with the goals of maintaining a structurally balanced budget, while continuing to address the priorities of the House of Delegates.

Mr. Chairman, in the area of capital, the Subcommittee's recommendations make progress on the backlog of projects approved in your 2016 capital program legislation. Specifically, the Subcommittee recommends about \$780 million to address several major projects, most significantly, the replacement of the Central State Hospital. In addition, the Subcommittee is pleased to be able to provide funding for other major projects including the renovation of Alderman Library at UVA, the construction of the STEM Lab Building at VCU, and IT Infrastructure at George Mason. Staff will review the details of the project pool.

Mr. Chairman, the Subcommittee also recommends \$45.8 million as the first of a four-year replacement phase-in of the STARS Radio System. In addition, two major projects involving Virginia Tech are include in the Subcommittees recommendations-the Innovation Campus and the Data and Decision Science Building. Both projects will support the tech talent pipeline degree production needs for Amazon and beyond.


Mr. Chairman, the Subcommittee is also recommending language to require the Department of General Services (DGS), with oversight from the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission, to review the statute of limitations policy on state contracts for construction services. The language requires DGS to consult with governmental bodies and representative from the private sector construction community. DGS will report its findings and recommendations before the next session, so we can address this issue properly.

In the area of general government, much of the work of the Subcommittee involved identifying areas within its purview where legislation or strategic

investments were needed to improve the core operations of government. With this goal in mind, the Subcommittee is recommending \$1.5 million to fund 32 positions within the offices of our Commonwealths' Attorney which will fund 20% of the position shortfall based on the Compensation Board's staffing standards. The Subcommittee is also recommending \$400,000 from the general fund pursuant to the adoption of House Bill 1668 which is a comprehensive effort to improve the management of government contracts through increased oversight by agencies with the most experience negotiating and managing contracts. The recommendations also include \$1.3 million from the general fund in funding actions for the Department of Elections, most of which is targeted to address deficiencies identified in the recent JLARC study.

The details of the Subcommittee's report are contained in the attachments. Committee staff will now review our recommendations in greater detail, Mr. Chairman, Members of the Committee, we hope it will be your pleasure to adopt the report.


