Co-Chairs and Members of the Committee:

Your Subcommittee has reviewed the Governor's introduced budget for public education. As the Subcommittee developed its recommendations, we focused on efforts to support our teachers and school staff and to help students succeed.

Overall, our recommendations provide an additional \$588.7 million to Direct Aid over the biennium. Combined with the \$443.9 million in the introduced budget, this brings total new funding to \$1.0 billion. When combined with the adopted increases in the current budget, we will invest \$3.9 billion in Public Education.

To better support our teachers and students, we propose \$270.6 million to fully lift the support position cap and \$56.9 million to ensure students have access to trained specialized support staff. Combined, these investments will provide additional resources to schools and alleviate the pressures on teachers and staff to meet the growing needs of students.

To help our students with the highest learning needs and to respond to learning loss, we provide \$38.6 million to support more instructional aides in the classrooms; \$37.1 million to increase the At-Risk Add On; and \$24.3 million to support English Language Learners. We also continue to focus on improving reading literacy by including \$27.5 million to expand reading specialists through eighth grade.

To recognize the importance that our teachers and staff provide, we recommend an additional two percent salary increase in FY 2024. This provides an increase of seven percent beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> of this year. We also propose to fully fund a \$1,000 bonus for instruction and support positions in December of this year. These actions help us support teachers and staff and demonstrate the value of what teachers do to educate the next generation.

Regarding school safety and security, the recent incidents in Newport News and the many concerns across the state emphasize the need to support efforts that help students, teachers, and staff feel safe, so they can focus on learning. As a result, we propose \$50.0 million in grants to focus on equipment and school modifications to improve school security. Additionally, there are contingent allocations of \$100.0 million for school construction grants and \$80.0 million to support childcare providers once federal relief funds are exhausted.

Lastly, the recent announcement of an unintentional error in the Direct Aid Calculator Tool creates a potential financial burden for some school divisions. We provide \$58.1 million to hold divisions harmless in FY 2023 and additional new funding in FY 2024 eases any financial pressures to localities.

The Subcommittee continues with its commitment to support and to respond to the challenges faced by our students and educators. I thank the Subcommittee members and I look forward to continuing our on-going work regarding the future of public education in the Commonwealth.

I hope it will be the pleasure of the Committee to adopt our amendments. This completes the report of your K-12 Education Subcommittee.

"48. Temporary Instructional Assistants

a. Out of this appropriation, \$38,580,470 the second year from the general fund is provided as temporary funding for instructional assistants in underperforming schools to (i) help teachers provide small group and individualized instruction, (ii) help teachers manage students within classrooms, and (iii) reduce teacher workloads. From this amount, the state share of one instructional assistant per 20 students in fall membership shall be provided for each school that did not meet performance benchmarks for three or more school quality indicators based on the Board of Education's most recent accreditation calculations.

b. These payments are available to any school division with a qualifying school that certifies to the Department of Education the number of eligible instructional assistants deployed in qualifying schools, not to include any instructional assistants funded through the Standards of Quality. The Department of Education shall prorate funding for school divisions that certify fewer eligible instructional assistants deployed than the number qualified for funding through this program.

c. This funding is intended to be temporary and shall cease at the end of fiscal year 2026."

**Explanation:**

(This amendment provides additional, temporary funding of \$38.6 million GF the second year for a subset of schools accredited with conditions to hire instructional assistants at a ratio of one assistant per 20 students in schools that do not meet three or more of the Board of Education's performance benchmarks for school accreditation. These positions are intended to (i) help teachers provide small group and individualized instruction necessitated by widening academic needs within classrooms, (ii) help teachers manage challenging student behaviors within classrooms, and (iii) reduce teacher workloads. This is a recommendation from JLARC's 2022 study: "Pandemic Impact on Public K-12 Education.")

"47. Hold Harmless for the Grocery Tax Hold Harmless Error in Direct Aid Calculator

a. Out of this appropriation, \$58,074,430 the first year from the general fund is provided to local school divisions as hold harmless payments in support of the Standards of Quality for the identified error in the Direct Aid calculator for the Supplemental General Fund Payment in Lieu of Sales Tax on Food and Personal Hygiene and Basic Aid offset. Local governing bodies shall appropriate these funds to school divisions in the same manner as they appropriate sales tax revenues dedicated to public education.

b. The one-time hold harmless payments represent the projected net decrease in state payments to local school divisions from the error in the Direct Aid calculator as reflected for Chapter 2 of the 2022 Special Session I."

**Explanation:**

(This amendment provides \$58.1 million GF the first year for a hold harmless payment to cover the identified error in the Direct Aid calculator tool from the Supplemental Supplemental General Fund Payment in Lieu of Sales Tax on Food and Personal Hygiene and Basic Aid offset. These funds represent the total impact to divisions in fiscal year 2023.)
