

# Amend Tobacco Tax Language Consistent with Provisions of HB 1417

## **Adjustments and Modifications to Tax Collections**

Cigarette Tax, Tobacco Products Tax and Tax on Liquid Nicotine

Language

### Language:

Page 654, line 17, after "date." insert:

"Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning July 1, 2023, the rate of the tobacco products tax upon cigars shall be 10 percent of the manufacturer's sales price of such cigars or \$0.30 per cigar, whichever is less."

### Explanation:

(This amendment amends language included in the introduced budget regarding the rate at which Other Tobacco Products are taxed to conform to the provisions of House Bill 1417 as it passed the House.)
